



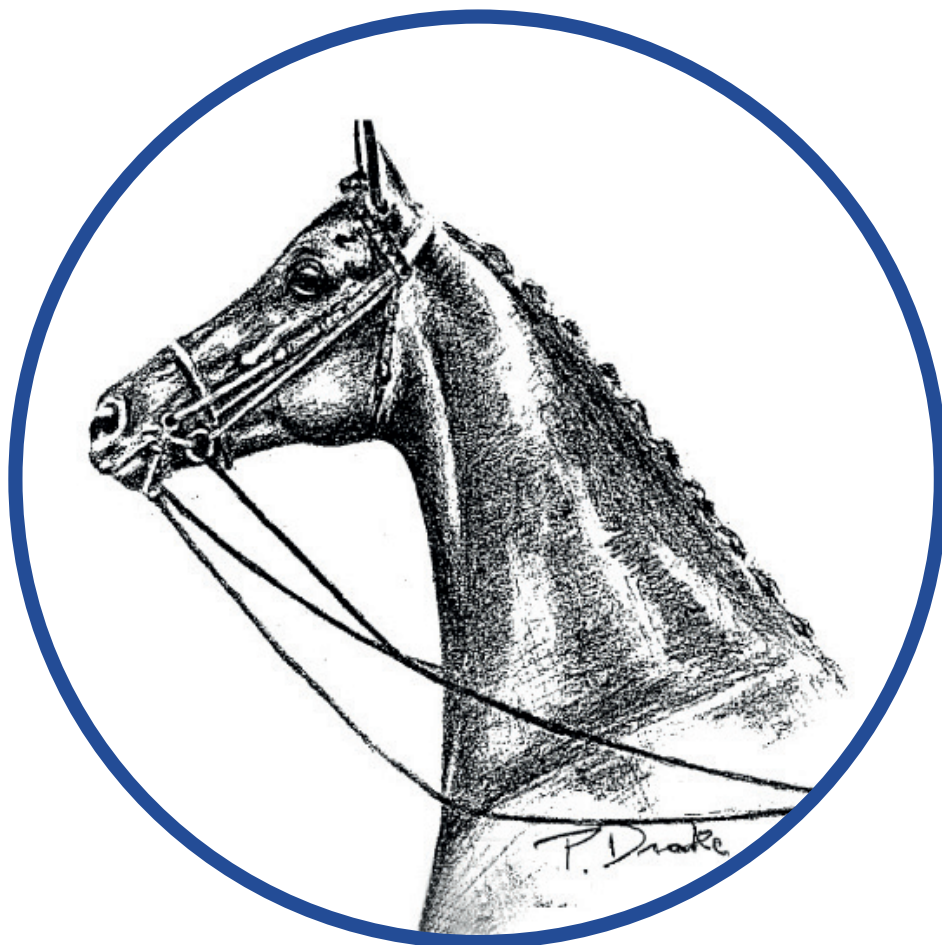

Ring One - 8AM START

Judge - Helen Taylor

Class 1: BSPS Novice Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 2: BSPS Novice Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 122cms and not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 3: BSPS Novice Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 4: BSPS Novice Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 5: THE BSPS NOVICE LEADING REIN PONY OF HUNTER TYPE Ponies not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

NOVICE CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASSES 1-5) OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!

Class 6: BSPS Open (Restricted) Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 7: BSPS Open (Restricted) Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 122cms and not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 8: BSPS Open (Restricted) Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 9: BSPS Open (Restricted) Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

OPEN SHOW HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASSES 6-9) OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!

Class 10: BSPS Open Leading Rein Pony of Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 11: BSPS Open First Pony of a Hunter Type. Mare or Geldling 4 years old or over not exceeding 122 cms. Snaffle bridles only. No cantering is allowed except for individual performance. *Ponies must leave the ring at walk or trot. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.*

**MINI CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASSES 10-11)
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!**

Class 12: BSPS Novice Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 13th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 13: BSPS Novice Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 15th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 14: BSPS Novice Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

**NOVICE SHOW PONY CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASSES 12-14)
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!**

Class 15: BSPS Novice Leading Rein Show Pony. Ponies not exceeding 122 cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current Year.

Class 16: BSPS Novice First Ridden Show Pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122 cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

**NOVICE MINI CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASSES 15-16)
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!**

Class 17: BSPS Open (Restricted) Leading Rein Show Pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 8th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 18: BSPS Open (Restricted) First Ridden Show Pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

**OPEN MINI CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASSES 17-18)
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!**

Class 19: BSPS Open (Restricted) Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 13th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 20: BSPS Open (Restricted) Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 15th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 21: BSPS Open (Restricted) Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

**OPEN SHOW PONY CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASSES 19-21)
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!**

Class 22: Open Part Bred - Mare or gelding 4 years or not exceeding 148cms. Riders any age.

Class 23: Tiny Tots First Time in Show Ring Leading Rein ponies not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 5th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Open to both plaited and Heritage ponies.

Class 24: Tiny Tots Leading Rein ponies not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 5th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Open to both plaited and Heritage ponies.

Class 25: BSPS TINY TOTS WALK AND TROT CLASS Plaited or Heritage Ponies not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies will only walk and trot in this class.

Class 26: BSPS TINY TOTS RIDDEN Plaited or Heritage Ponies not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. In this class Ponies will be asked to canter in their individual shows only.

TINY TOTS CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASSES 23-26). OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!

Ring Two - 8AM START

Class 27: THE BSPS NOVICE INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE Animals ex.146cms. but not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 28: THE BSPS NOVICE INTERMEDIATE SHOW HUNTER Animals ex. 148cms., But not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASSES 27-28) OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!

Class 29: BSPS Open (Restricted) Intermediate Show Hunter. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 30: BSPS Open (Restricted) Small Intermediate Show Riding Type exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 31: BSPS Open (Restricted) Large Intermediate Show Riding Type exceeding 153cms but not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASSES 29-31) OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!

HORSE CLASSES:

Class 32: Open Hack Class - Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exc 148cms but not exceeding 160cm. Rider any age. Horses will NOT be ridden by the judge but will be required to give a short show.

Class 33: Open Cob Class - Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exc 148cms. Rider any age. Horses will NOT be ridden by the judge but will be required to give a short show.

Class 34: Riding Horse - Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exc 148cms. Rider any age. Horses will NOT be ridden by the judge but will be required to give a short show.

Class 35: Open Hunter - Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exc 148cms. Rider any age. Horses will NOT be ridden by the judge but will be required to give a short show. .

Class 36: Irish Draft - Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exc 148cms. Rider any age. Horses will NOT be ridden by the judge but will be required to give a short show.

Class 37: Part Bred - Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exc 148cms. Rider any age. Horses will NOT be ridden by the judge but will be required to give a short show.

Class 38: Mixed Type Coloured. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over. Horse or Pony - any height. Riders any age.

Class 39: Amateur Ridden Horse Class. Mare or Gelding 4 Year Old or over Horse any height. Riders any age.

HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASSES 32-39) OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!

Class 40: BSPS M&M Novice Lead Rein. Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 41: BSPS M&M Novice First Ridden. Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

NOVICE MINI CHAMPIONSHIP (40-41) OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!

Class 42: BSPS M&M Novice Ridden Small Breeds registered in the breed society stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and Welsh B. Ponies 4 years old and over. Riders any age.

Class 43: BSPS M&M Novice Ridden Large Breeds registered in the breed society stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D. Riders any age.

**NOVICE M & M CHAMPIONSHIP (42-43)
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!**

Class 44: BSPS Heritage Open Lead Rein. Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 45: BSPS Heritage Open First Ridden. Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

**OPEN MINI CHAMPIONSHIP (44-45)
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!**

Class 46: BSPS OPEN (Restricted) Ridden Small Breeds registered in the breed society stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and Welsh B. Ponies 4 years old and over. Riders any age.

Class 47: BSPS OPEN (Restricted) Ridden Large Breeds registered in the breed society stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D. Riders any age.

**OPEN M & M CHAMPIONSHIP (46-47)
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS!**

! Please read:

All ponies must be 4 years old or over.

Rosettes to 5th place in all classes.

These will not be presented in the ring, you will be asked to collect rosettes after your class.

Whilst NOT competing.

Please remain in your lorry/car.

You will have to create your own number.

You will be contacted prior to the show with your allocated number.

Only 3 people per horse/pony are allowed at the show.

No spectators or members of the general public allowed.

Rules and conditions

This show is affiliated to the BSPS and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the BSPS classes whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

Neither the BSPS Area 3B committee, nor any of its officers, servants or assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal or property in connection with this show.

Each exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the judges, referees, chief steward and officials of the show.

The judges in the schedule have accepted our invitation to judge, but the committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes if necessary.

No exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of rule 486 by the judge.

Any pony taking part in classes judged under BSPS rules will be liable to dope testing.

No Refund of entries will be made, except in the event of unforeseen cancellation of the show, when a £7 levy per entry will be made to cover administration costs.

In all classes correctly secured British Standard skull caps/Riding Hats that meet current safety standards MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted.

Entries at this show are limited to 10 per class.

Entries will be open from Tuesday March 9th (6pm) to Sunday March 28th.

Entries are £20 per class.

Please provide your email address, your mobile phone number and any vehicle registrations that will be attending the show that associate with you (clients cars)! If you do not, then the vehicle will not be allowed to enter the event.

Do NOT arrive any sooner that 1 hour before your class, this allows plenty of time to tack up and warm up.

Once you have finished your class please return to your lorry and leave the centre.

Guidelines for exhibitors/members at shows

- The society expects each member/exhibitor to take personal responsibility for not spreading the Covid-19 virus and obeying all rules regarding social distancing.

Failure to do so will result in removal from the showground.

Please do not attend if you are classified as being in a vulnerable category as per government guidelines.

Events will only take place when government guidelines allows them to do so.

- **DO NOT attend if you are displaying any signs on the Coronavirus symptoms.**

- Social distance from members other than your family group by 2 metres (or current government guidelines).
- Must use hand sanitisers on regular basis.
- Wash hands thoroughly on arrival and after using any facilities throughout the day.
- Use lorry toilets where possible to minimise the risk.
- Obey orders given by loudspeaker system regarding social distancing.
- Wear face coverings wherever possible to avoid spreading the virus.
- Temperature checks MAY be taken during the show.
- Ensure you arrive in the designated vehicle on your entry and be prepared to give names of occupants on arrival at the Show.
- Ensure you park lorries and cars safely where directed by the officials.
- Abide by the Rules in the Schedule.
- Only animals competing at the show will be allowed on the showground.
- Show Organisers have taken responsibility to set safeguards in place for exhibitors but attendance at the Show is at your own risk.
