

Ponies placed first in BSPS open classes will qualify for the **BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS** at the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

The Blue Riband Pony of the Year – The 1st and 2nd prize winners in the Open LR, Open FR or Open WHP or Open SHP or Open Intermediate WH, SRT and SH will qualify.

THE IRISH DRAUGHT HORSE SOCIETY (GB) £2000 RIDDEN CHALLENGE

This show is a qualifier for the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge. The highest placed horse (not already qualified) from each of the following classes (1-11, 54-60)

the class numbers) that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register,

with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding, will qualify for the final of the IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge. Horses need not be registered with the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) to qualify but must be on the IDHS (GB) Registers by the time of the Championship, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show on 13th and 14th August 2022 at

Onley Equestrian Centre, Onley Grounds Farm, Willoughby, Rugby, Warwickshire CV23 8AJ.

In the final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money and a trophy. The Reserve Champion will be awarded £500, and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition the highest placed Purebred Irish Draught will receive a trophy and £100, and the highest placed Sport Horse will receive a trophy and £50.

A horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a card. Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at www.idhsgb.org.uk to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the final.

BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Competitors & Horses must be registered or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket. Horses registered with the Association must be Owned, Exhibited and Ridden by current BSHA Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older.

Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.

Classes 52,53,55,56,57,59 and 60 are qualifying classes for the Royal International Horse Show. The first in each class will qualify, if 1st has already qualified 2nd will qualify. If 1st & 2nd have already qualified then 3rd will qualify. The 1st or highest placed unqualified prize winners in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic of the Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2022. Horses competing in Sport Horse Breeding classes of (GB) classes at affiliated shows cannot compete in Hack & Riding Horse classes at the same show. This does not apply to SHB(GB) Ridden Sport Horse Classes.

DAY TICKETS Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider and Open Affiliated classes only, but will NOT allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form from the BSHA website. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open

class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes).

SPORT HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN The Show is affiliated to the S.H.B.(G.B.) and competitors are REQUIRED to abide by its 2022 rules and regulations. Please refer to the SHB of (GB) Rule Book. Owners, Riders and Producers of horses competing in RIHS classes run in accordance with Sport Horse Breeding of GB must be a member of the society & horses must be on the SHB(GB) basic id or have passports over stamped by SHB(GB) & if RIHS horses must on 2022 show hunter registration or compete on a SHB(GB) day ticketorder for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB (GB) office within 14 days.

Classes 3-8 & 81 are qualifying classes for the 2022 Royal International Horse Show.

AMATEUR RULES & DEFINITION. It is expected that Exhibitors will compete in the true spirit of these Rules. The Directors/Board/Council reserve the right. in their absolute discretion. to reclassify an Exhibitor's Amateur status/entry should they deem in necessary.

Ownership: All owners should be registered in the passport as per the latest DEFRA regulations.

Professional Producer/trainer/Rider: A person who undertakes the preparation/training keeping at livery. production of equine rider or competes as a Rider or jobbing Rider

No commercial branding can be visible in the ring, during Amateur classes. this applies to equines, riders and any attendees.

a)Professional Showing Status: anyone who has operated as a Professional Showing Producer, Rider or Groom will, for the purposes of these Rules, always be deemed a professional; including when acting as a groom

b)Amateur Status – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not (i) judge at an affiliated show as of 1st January in the current year.

c)Amateur Status - a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/ she does not, during the current or previous season: (i) Engage in breeding, livery- buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity, or as means of deriving a source of income. (ii) Receive remuneration, whether it be monetary or goods in kind, for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing. livery stable or riding school (instruction at pony Club and Riding Club excepted), This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets. (iii) Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools. events Centre. stud o! livery yard in any capacity or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule. immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the Equestrian establishment will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment. (iv) Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador in any showing classes- SHB(GB) or otherwise. or a Hone for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned. A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit. which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in ani open classes, SHB(GB) or otherwise, with the exception of Open Working classes and Side Saddle class's, during the current year and the following year up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show. (The above Rule does not apply if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and ONLY ridden by a Professional. during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership. (v) if you ride compete Equines on a regular basis, which you do not stable at home, your Amateur status will be reviewed by the Board/council, i.e., if you ride/compete multiple equines or ride regularly for one or more owners you could be deemed profession.

On the day when an Exhibit is competing in Amateur classes, Professionals, including Professional Grooms, are not allowed to ride. to work-in (in any form) compete, or enter the Ring to groom/strip the Horse.

d) Amateur Owner/Rider: Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur, No professional, including Professional Grooms are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

e) Amateur Home Produced: Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D.I.Y yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional, including Professional Grooms are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

f) MEMBER. A fully paid-up life full associate or supporter member of the Society. g) OWNER. An owner of a horse registered with the Society.

h) IMMEDIATE FAMILY - The following are classed as immediate Family for the purpose of this rule book: Grandparents, Parents/Parents Partners, Husband/wife & Partners, Brothers & Sisters, Sons/Daughters, Step Parents, Step Brothers/Sisters, Legal Guardians, Sister & Brother In Laws, Uncle & Aunt, Niece & Nephew

i) AGE OF RIDER/HANDLER. No rider/handler under sixteen years of age on the day of the show is eligible to compete in any classes affiliated to the Society. Proof of age may be required.

j) SENIOR JUDGE. In the event of a dispute the conformation judge is deemed to be the senior Judge.

BRITISH SKEWBALD AND PIEBALD ASSOCIATION Classes 12-15 are affiliated to the British Skewbald & Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead and the BSPA WCC. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules - download from www.bspaonline.com. All horses / ponies must be registered and all owners and riders must be BSPA members prior to the show. Rider's age taken from 1st January. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cms and under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate. All stallions must be graded with BSPA and in possession of a BSPA stallion ID card which must be carried at all times and produced on request. All stallions must wear a 2022 Blue BSPA Stallion disc. No rider under 15 may exhibit a stallion in any class. No competitor / owner / horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2022 membership of BSPA and a RIHS gualification card. Qualification: 1st place and the next ungualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd gualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place. Skewbald & Piebald horses / ponies only. Highest placed amateur and highest placed junior in each class qualify for the Amateur and Junior Supreme Championship finals to be held at BSPA World of Colour Championships at College Equestrian Centre, Keysoe, Bedfordshire. IRISH DRAUGHT RIDDEN CLASSES These classes are affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Soc.(GB) and only horses reg. with or overstamped by the IDHS(GB in the correct ownership are eligible for entry, registration number must be stated on the entry form and entries will be sent to the IDHS(GB) prior to the show to confirm their eligibility. All competing stallions must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (ID Class 1, Class 2, RID(GB) AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID(GB) stallion and be inspected or overstamped by the IDHS(GB) and classified as RID(GB),ID Class 1 or Class 2 or be a registered Irish Draught Sport Horse and must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails. The owners of all Pure-bred Irish Draught in ridden classes must be full members of the IDHS(GB). This rule does not apply to owners of Irish Draught Sporthorses. Riders of stallions must be 18 years or over. This show is a qualifier for the IDHS (GB) £2000 Ridden Challenge. Classes 9, 10 & 11 are eligible. The highest placed horse (not already qualified) from each class will qualify for the Final of the IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show N.B: A horse may only qualify for the Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a card. Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at www.idhsgb.org.uk to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the Final. See website for prizes.

THE SIDE SADDLE ASSOCIATION EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIPS OPEN QUALIFYING CLASS Run under SSA Rules defined in the current Members' Handbook. Open to SSA Members and Non-Members. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd Adult and 3rd Junior places and SSA Championship Points. Southernden Farm offers a rosette to the highest placed Member aged under 14 on 1st January of the current year. A rosette in memory of The Late Mr R Philpot is offered to the Adult Member and Manor Grange Stud Show Centre to the Junior Member, judged to be the best turned out. Competitors must wear a hat to current Safety Standard or above.

CLASSICAL LADIES SIDE SADDLE QUALIFIER Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-members, aged 18 and over on January 1st of the current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). To be judged 25% conformation and action, 25% manners & way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider, by a SHBGB, BSHA or SSA Panel Judge. Judges may request a short show but will not ride exhibits; horses will not be stripped. Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes NOT permitted. Competitors must wear a hat to current Safety Standard or above. Judges must use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination gualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. In the event of previous gualification, this may be passed down to fourth place. Special rosettes are offered by Mrs T Mitchell & Mr L Mitchell to the winner and if the winner has already gualified, a second rosette is awarded with the Qualification Card. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only...The four highest placed Riding Horse, Hack (not ex 160cm), Cob or Hunter, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, ridden by a SSA Adult Member qualify for the current year's BSHA Championship Show Mears Ladies Show Horse Championship and if already qualified the ticket will go to the next highest placed horse down to 5th place. Combinations qualifying after the current year's BSHA Championship Show may carry forward the qualification, to the following year. SSA Members who qualify for The Mears Ladies Show Horse Championship, will not be required to join the BSHA in order to compete in any Side Saddle class at the BSHA National Championship Show. If the BSHA Championship Show entries have closed at the time of qualification, competitors will not be charged a late entry fee for the Championship

BEST HORSE OR PONY RIDDEN SIDE SADDLE Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over: conformation & manners will be taken into consideration; horses/ponies will not be stripped. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards.

The Highest placed coloured exhibit ridden by a competitor aged 16 years or over (who has not already qualified) receives a Special Rosette and qualifies for the Side Saddle Final at the CHAPS Championship Show. Open to any type of exhibit. Riders/Owners need not be a member or their exhibit registered with CHAPS at the time of qualification, but in order to compete at the Championships, the Rider/Owner must be a showing member and their horse/pony registered with CHAPS before entering the final. Lead Rein competitors are eligible for this class. Leaders must be correctly dressed. Combinations qualifying after the current year's CHAPS Final may carry forward the qualification, to the following year.

DEFINITIONS - HORSE HUNTER A mare or gelding capable or likely to be capable of carrying its designated weight regularly for a full days hunting. It should have substance, quality and a calm, bold temperament. It should have the conformation to produce high performance with sustained soundness. It should be alert, and when ridden have four athletic natural paces.

Class 1. Novice Hunter (unaffiliated) Mare or gelding 4 yrs old or over, not exc 148 cm) not having won a 1st prize of £60 or a total of £200 in prize money in any ridden hunter class at home or abroad before 1st Jan in current yr, excepting all prize money awarded in 4 year old classes.

Class 2. SHB(GB) 4 & 5 yr old Hunter class

AMATEUR HUNTER CLASSES

Class 3. RIHS Lightweight Amateur Mare or gelding 4yr or over capable of carrying 12 stone 7lbs.& under. Small Hunters to be included in this class.

Class 4. RIHS Heavyweight Amateur Mare or gelding 4 yr or over capable of carrying over 12 stone 7lbs. Middleweight Hunters to be included in this class.

Class 5. RIHS Lightweight Hunter Mare or gelding 4 yrs or over, capable of carrying up to 12s7lb.

Class 6. RIHS Middleweight Hunter Mare or gelding 4 yrs or over, capable of carrying up to 14st.

Class 7. RIHS Heavyweight Hunter Mare or gelding 4 yrs or over capable of carrying over 14st.

Class 8. RIHS Small Hunter Mare or gelding 4 yrs old & over ex 148cm (14.2) but not ex 158 (15.2). A Horse which is registered as a small Hunter cannot compete in an open weight class.

HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd from classes 5-8 to compete

IRISH DRAUGHT RIDDEN CLASSES

JUDGES: Kate Duxbury (R) Peter Craft (C)

Class 9. Open Ridden Small 4 yrs & over, stallion, mare or gelding, not to exceed 158cm, registered on the Irish Draught Breed Registers (main Studbook) or ID Sport Horse Registers.

Class 10. Ridden Irish Draught 4 yrs & over, stallion, mare or gelding, exceeding 158cm, registered on the Irish Draught Breed Registers (main Studbook).

Class 11. Ridden Irish Draught Sport Horse 4 yrs& over, stallion, mare or gelding, exceeding 158 cm, registered on the ID Sport Horse Registers or SID.

IRISH DRAUGHT CHAMPIONSHIP 1st and 2nd from classes 9-11 to compete

Class 12. BSPA RIHS Ridden ponies not ex. 153cm Plaited. No spurs to be worn judge will not ride, display required, no leading rein permitted.
