Classes **14-17, 18-22, 29-31, 34-35, 40-46, 50-52, 57-58 and 72-76** are **qualifying** Classes for the Royal International Horse Show. Only one pony from each class qualifies, and the highest placed (not already qualified), from the first 3 ponies in each class will qualify. All ponies in these classes must be owned, registered, and ridden by B.S.P.S. This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Championships Show.

The Best Rider competition for riders 25 years and under will be at all BSPS affiliated shows with a final at the BSPS Summer Championships. For further details please contact your Area Chairman.

Ponies placed first in BSPS open classes will qualify for the **BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS** at the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

The Blue Riband Pony of the Year – The 1st and 2nd prize winners in the Open LR, Open FR or Open WHP or Open SHP or Open Intermediate WH, SRT and SH will qualify.

The Hobby Horse of the year

Competitors will enter the ring and will perform a freestyle show for no longer than 2 minutes, marks will be awarded for:

co-ordination, balance, energy, and body control = 50 marks

overall performance of the show with elegance and appeal

All competitors must have a hobby horse/stick horse and be mounted as they compete. Shoes are required for all competitors. There is no specific dress code, but trainers or gym shoes should be flexible to point your toes. The arena to measure 7m x 14m. The judge signals when the competitor may enter the arena. The judge's decision is final. Your hobby horse can be plaited or unplaited. The top 3 in each section will qualify for the Final at The BSPS Summer Championships.

THE IRISH DRAUGHT HORSE SOCIETY (GB) £2000 RIDDEN CHALLENGE

This show is a qualifier for the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) £2000 Ridden Challenge. The highest placed horse_(not already qualified) from each of the following classes 9-11 that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sports Horse Register, with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught Breeding, will qualify for the final of the IDHS (GB) £2000 challenge. Horses need not be registered with the IDHS (GB) to qualify but must be on the IDHS (GB) Registers by the time of the Championships, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) National Championship Show on 7th & 8th September 2024 at Onley Equestrian Centre, Onley Grounds Farm, Willoughby, Rugby, Warwickshire CV23 8AJ.

In the Final, the Champion will be awarded £1000 prize money and a trophy. The Reserve Champion

will be awarded £500, and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Purebred Irish Draught will receive a trophy and £100, and the highest placed Sports Horse will receive £50.

A horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Qualifiers will be contacted by a member of the IDHS Show Team.

BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Competitors & Horses must be registered or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket. Horses registered with the Association must be Owned, Exhibited and Ridden by current BSHA Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older.

Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.

Classes **63-69** are qualifying classes for the Royal International Horse Show. The first in each class will qualify, if 1st has already qualified 2nd will qualify. If 1st & 2nd have already qualified, then 3rd will qualify. The highest placed unqualified exhibit in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Supreme of Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2024. Horses competing in Sport Horse Breeding classes of (GB) classes at affiliated shows cannot compete in Hack & Riding Horse classes at the same show. *This does not apply to SHB(GB) **Ridden Sport Horse Classes**.*

DAY TICKETS Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider and Open Affiliated classes only, but will NOT allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form from the BSHA website. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (except for Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes). Recipients of the young rider rosette will qualify for the BSHA young rider of the year, at the National Championship Show in September 2024.

Amateur classes 59-62 are qualifiers for the amateur championships at The Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed unqualified horse in each section in each class in the Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes will qualify for the RIHS Amateur final, with two highest placed unqualified horses qualifying in the Maxi Cob class. The BSHA offer a champion rosette to be awarded in the separate amateur championship. Please refer to rules 6&7 in the 2024 BSHA rulebook. The Amateur classes may be entered on a day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days in order to confirm qualification. **Please acquaint yourselves with the amateur rules 6&7 in the BSHA handbook.**

SPORT HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN

The Show is affiliated to the S.H.B.(G.B.) and competitors are REQUIRED to abide by its 2024 rules and regulations. Please refer to the SHB of (GB) Rule Book. Owners, Riders, and Producers of horses competing in RIHS classes run in accordance with Sport Horse Breeding of GB must be a member of the society. If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB (GB) office within 14 days.

For HOYS qualifiers all Riders, Owners and Producers must be members of Sports Horse Breeding GB, The Showing Register or The British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with Sports Horse Breeding GB, The Showing Register or The British Show Horse Association. HOYS classes cannot be entered on a day ticket.

Classes **1-2, 5-8 and 77** are qualifying classes for the Royal International Horse Show.

AMATEUR RULES – including Amateur Working Hunter AMATEUR. Please refer to 2024 SHB(GB) Amateur Rules & Definition. a). It is expected that Exhibitors will compete in the true spirit of these Rules. The Directors / Board / Council reserve the right, in their absolute discretion, to reclassify an Exhibitor's Amateur status/entry should they deem it necessary.

AMATEUR STATUS A person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association.

Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season:

. Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing, or hiring horses in a commercial capacity, or as means of deriving a source of income.

- Receive remuneration, whether it be monetary or goods in kind, for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.

- Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to; riding schools, events centre, stud, or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.

- Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador, in any showing classes, SHB(GB) or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned.

PLEASE NOTE: a). If you ride/compete equines on a regular basis, which you do not stable at home, your Amateur status will be reviewed by the Board/Council, i.e., if you ride/compete multiple equines or ride regularly for one or more owners, you could be deemed professional. b). A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in ANY class, SHB(GB) or otherwise, with the exception of Working classes, Side Saddle classes AND Novice classes, during the current year and the following year, up to

but not including the Royal International Horse Show. c). (The above Rule (b) does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and ONLY ridden by a Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership). d). On the day when an Exhibit is competing in Amateur classes, Professionals, including Professional Grooms, are not allowed to ride, to work-in (in any form), compete, or enter the Ring to groom/strip the Horse. e). No commercial branding can be visible in the ring, during Amateur classes (including Amateur Home Produced), this applies to equines, riders and any attendees; this also includes outside the ring, or online i.e. on social media. f). We may require a statement of your eligibility to compete in Home Produced classes. 1. AMATEUR CLASSES a). AMATEUR OWNER / RIDER: Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse. b). AMATEUR HOME PRODUCED: Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which

since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

BRITISH SKEWBALD AND PIEBALD ASSOCIATION

Classes **53-56** are affiliated to the British Skewbald & Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead Tuesday 27th July 2024 and the BSPA WCC. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules – download from www.bspaonline.com. All horses / ponies must be registered, and all owners and riders must be BSPA members prior to the show. Rider's age taken from 1st January. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cms and under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate. **Competitors qualifying at this show for the Royal International Horse Show 23rd-28th July 2024 Online entries will be open on 1st May and entries close 3rd June 2024. All Stallions must be graded and licensed by the BSPA for 2024 and must wear BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class.** No competitor / owner / horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2024 membership of BSPA and a RIHS qualification card. **Memberships/horse registrations must be in place before you enter classes.** Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place. Skewbald & Piebald horses / ponies only. Highest placed amateur and highest placed junior in each class qualify for the Amateur and Junior Supreme Championship finals to be held at BSPA World of Colour Championships Show September 2024. Cards to be shown and qualification card signed. All Champion and Reserve Champion winners will qualify for BSPA Star Championship at WCC. Class 7. RIHS Heavyweight Hunter Mare or gelding 4 yrs or over capable of carrying over 14st.

Class 8. RIHS Small Hunter Mare or gelding 4 yrs old & over ex 148cm (14.2) but not ex 158 (15.2). A Horse which is registered as a small Hunter cannot compete in an open weight class.

Class 11. Ridden Irish Draught Sport Horse 4 yrs & over, stallion, mare, or gelding, exceeding 158 cm, registered on the ID Sport Horse Registers or SID.

Class 13. BSPS Mixed Height Open Show Hunter Pony. Mare or gelding 4 yrs & over not ex 153cm. Riders MUST be the correct age for the animal they ride.

Class 14. RIHS. BSPS Open Pony of Show Hunter Type Ex 143cm not Ex 153cm Mare or gelding 4 yrs & over. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st Jan in current year.

Class 15. RIHS BSPS Open Pony of Show Hunter Type Ex. 133cm not Ex 143cm Mare or gelding 4 yrs & over. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st Jan in current year.

Class 16. RIHS BSPS Open Pony of Show Hunter Type Ex. 123cm not Ex 133cm. Mare or gelding 4 yrs & over. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st Jan in current year.

Class 17. RIHS BSPS Open Pony of Show Hunter Type not exceeding 123 cm. Mare or gelding 4 yrs & over. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan in current year.
